INSTITUTION F

This institution reported having fourteen patent applications in the past ten years, seven taken out in the name of a university-related research laboratory and now owned by Research Corporation. INSTITUTION O

This institution, which has an established patent policy, reports that in the past ten years some 10 to 15 possibly patentable inventions have been submitted to Research Corporation or University Patents, Inc. (although only two patents are known to have been issued), and that in that period about the same number of invention disclosures have been made to the Government. Gross income to the institution is estimated at \$1,000 to \$2,000 per year for the past five years, these royalties coming as a result of licenses granted to organizations sponsoring research resulting in patentable inventions.
