



- Courses Objectives
 - Training scientists and engineers to become European Patent Attorneys
 - Training lawyers and jurists to become legal experts in IP fields
- Teaching Language : French (80%), English (20%)
- Diploma Delivered
 - University Diploma
 - Master Diploma



IP Law Courses in French Section

University Diploma

- Extensive Program
 - For scientists and engineers with no professional experience intending to become patent attorneys
 - Two options (one semester for each option)
 - Invention Patent Option
 - Trademark, Designs and Model Option

- Accelerated Program
 - For young professionals intending to practise other legal professions in IP fields
 - Two options
 - Invention Patent Courses (8 weeks)
 - Trademarks, Designs and Model Courses (6 weeks)

- Intellectual Property, Distribution and International Commerce Law (1 academic year)
 - For corporate lawyers, business school graduates
 - Training the business-lawyers responsible for developing and marketing products and service related to Intellectual Property Rights





 - For young professionals
 - EQE Preparation
 - Providing a complete and comprehensive tuition on the legal basics and practice of European Patent law
 - Available in 33 European Cities
 - Collaborated with EPI, EPO



IP Law Courses in International Section

- Seminar Training Courses (2 five-days seminars)
 - For EQE Candidates
 - Two Seminars in January and February each year
 - Seminar D: Legal questions
 - Seminar ABC: Claim drafting (A), Claim amendment and response to communication (B), Opposition (C)
 - Two groups: Mechanical/Chemical
 - Teaching language: Three official EPO languages (German, French, English)
 - With the participation of EPO



IP Law Courses in International Section

- Training Courses for Civil Servants from Developing Countries (2 weeks)
 - For senior civil servants
 - Providing an intensive training courses on the recent development of IPR
 - Within the framework of the cooperation agreement with WIPO
 - Collaborated with INPI France
 - Teaching Language: English, French (with simultaneous translation)

- Special Training Courses
 - Two type of Training Courses
 - For magistrates of the member states of the Munich Convention
 - For magistrates and patent attorneys from countries entering the European Patent System
 - Teaching Language: English
