INTRODUCTION.

SOMEONE has said that there is a reason for all books, but the reason for some is so obscure that even the prefatory excuse of the author cannot make it clear to many of the readers. The reason for this volume, however, is apparent. The distinct, expressed demand existed long before the appearance of the first edition and has since been greatly emphasized. The numerous daily inquiries at our office for the identification of trade-marks, some of which have been published in the columns of *THE JEWELERS' CIRCULAR-WEEKLY*, form a striking manifestation of this demand. There is hardly a jeweler in the country who has not frequent requests for the duplication of articles, a piece of silverware, perhaps, of which others are needed to complete a set, or an article of jewelry, prized for one reason or another, of which a similar one is desired. Any book of reference that will enable the jeweler to identify the maker of the goods will result not only to his pecuniary benefit by assisting in effecting a sale, or in gaining or retaining the good-will of the customer, but will also aid in establishing for him a reputation as one well versed in his craft. It is not necessary, therefore, to offer any excuse for this volume, but a few remarks on the general scope and special features of this work will not be out of place.

When the first volume of "Trade-Marks of the Jewelry and Kindred Trades" appeared, it adequately met the demand as it then existed, but the great increase during the past five years in the number of manufacturers of jewelry and kindred lines, and the stimulus which the book gave to the adoption of marks by many firms who had not previously used a stamp, have made imperative the issuing of a second and revised edition. When it is considered that the first edition contained 1,800 marks, a number so large as to be a surprise to the trade at the time, and that this second edition contains 4,000 marks, it will be appreciated how evident is the demand for a new volume brought up to date.

The compiling of these 4,000 trade-marks has been no easy task, and we desire here to express our thanks to the members of the trade for their encouragement and co-operation. We do not claim that this volume is complete, for, like a dictionary or encyclopedia, it cannot be complete. There are, undoubtedly, some marks so lost in obscurity, so seldom used, or stamped on special orders only, that they may not be found in these pages, but no pains were spared, no source of information neglected, to make this work as thorough as possible. The marks have been plainly drawn and engraved in large size, so that all the details of every design are distinct. A two-fold consideration actuated this idea. First: Many designs approach each other so closely in general character that when stamped in miniature in the metal their differentiation by the ordinary eye is a difficult matter; therefore, their accurate reproduction in large size, showing every detail of their design, makes identification certain. Second: By reference to these carefully and accurately enlarged reproductions, a maker, who, in designing a new

mark, conscientiously desires to avoid adopting any device that may resemble another already existing, may steer clear from legal complications and pecuniary loss. Every mark that has been registered in the United States Patent Office is so marked, and those that have been discontinued are, so far as it was possible to ascertain, so designated. We might add here, that the publication of these discontinued marks, most of which are still found on goods, is of as great, if not greater importance than that of marks in current use.

It is desirable that a work on trade-marks, such as we here present, to be thoroughly useful should contain matters bearing upon legislation having reference to trade-marks. This work, therefore, contains a reprint of the National Trade-Mark Laws, with complete rules and forms adopted by the United States Patent Office for the registration of trade-marks; Treasury Department Trade-Mark Regulations: A digest of the national law and of the common law bearing upon the subject of trade-marks, prepared especially for this book by a well known lawyer, and reprints of the laws passed in seventeen States of the Union, regulating the sale of goods marked "sterling," "sterling silver," "coin" and "coin silver," and the laws passed in three States regulating the stamping of the karat on gold goods. As it is an almost universal practice among manufacturers to stamp on their products some mark designating quality, in connection with their individual marks, it will be seen that the relation between these laws and trade-marks is very intimate. The reprint of these stamping laws, occupying 16 pages, forms in itself a handy work of reference for manufacturers and dealers alike.

A necessary adjunct to a work of this character, it would seem, is a history of the systems of stamping and marking, obtaining among the workers in the precious metals of past generations. The essay entitled "Historical Sketch of Makers' Marks," by J. H. Buck, especially prepared for this book, reviews the subject of stamping and marking from mediæval times to modern days, while the essay "Marks of Gold and Silver Smiths," by F. W. Fairholt, brings the history down to fifty years ago. The latter essay appeared in the *London Art Journal* for October, 1855, and is remarkably comprehensive and exhaustive. Undoubtedly few copies of this issue of the *Art Journal* are extant, and it was our desire to preserve this valuable contribution to the literature of gold and silver smithing, as well as its appropriateness, which led us to include it in this volume.

This second edition of "Trade-Marks of the Jewelry and Kindred Trades," besides illustrating more than twice as many trade-marks, contains many features not comprised in the first edition. One specially worth mentioning is the article entitled "English Silversmiths and Their Marks," which gives a brief historical sketch of the leading manufacturers of silverware in England, together with the marks they now stamp upon their product and those which they used in an earlier period of their career. This is of considerable value on account of the great amount of English plate still found in this country. Another article worth noting here is the "Summary of London Hall Marks," which we believe is the only correct, explicit summary of these marks ever published. Still another feature is the alphabetical index to letters and words used as trade-marks, or parts of trade-marks, which will facilitate the identifying of many marks. We, therefore, present "Trade-Marks of the Jewelry and Kindred Trades" as the fruit of our most careful research and earnest labor, hoping that the demand for such a work, so clearly evident, has been satisfactorily filled.

EXPLANATORY NOTES ON INDEXES.

To facilitate the finding of any mark, this book contains three indexes.

1. Index to Classifications

The marks are arranged in groups according to the line of goods upon which they are stamped, and these groups follow each other in logical order, according to their relative importance in the trade, but a reference to the above index will enable one to readily find on what pages the marks stamped on any particular line of goods may be found.

2. Alphabetical Index to Makers and Dealers Having Trade-Marks

pages 249-254

A reference to this index will show upon what pages the marks of any individual, firm or corporation appear.

3. Alphabetical Index to Letters and Words Used as Trade-Marks or Parts of Trade-Marks

pages 254-261

As most trade-marks contain some letters or words, and as there is sometimes doubt as to which classification the trade-mark belongs, we have prepared this index, which will readily show upon what page the illustration of any mark containing a letter or word, may be found. In the case of monograms, where it is difficult to determine which initial comes first, it is advisable, in consulting the index, to look for each letter of the monogram until the combination forming the monogram is found. If the letter, or letters, sought are not found in this index then consult the main list of the book, as frequently a letter when stamped in miniature in the gold or silver will resemble another; a "G" often simulating a "C," a "D" appearing like an "O," etc.
