RICHARD S. PHILLIPS, being sworn, says:

1. He is a member of the firm of Hofgren, Wegner, Allen, Stellman & McCord, and is associate local counsel for Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., Defendant and Counterclaimant in the above entitled action.

2. Robert H. Rines of Boston, Massachusetts, is patent counsel for defendant Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., prepared the defense and counterclaim herein and intends to try the case. 3. This case was placed on the trial call on May 1, 1967; was reset to May 16, 1967; was reset to May 23, 1967; was reset to May 25, 1967; and was reset to May 29, 1967. The case presently appears to follow 65 C 1956, 65 C 1070 and 65 C 1172.

4. On May 22, 1967, the Court reset to May 31, 1967, two lower numbered cases, 66 C 267 and 66 C 381. I have been in close contact with counsel in these cases and am informed that the cases will not be settled and may require several weeks total trial time.

5. Trial counsel Rines and Isaac S. Blonder, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Blonder-Tongue Laboratories, Inc., the defendant herein, have held themselves in readiness for trial throughout the month of May 1967.
